

SEARCHING / BROWSING THE TOP 60,000 WORDS (see [video](#))

In COCA and iWeb, users can **browse through** a list of the **top 60,000 words** in the corpus (these are the only large, carefully corrected frequency lists of English). The small extracts below show samples of words at three different frequency bands: near 5,000 (i.e. the 5,000th most frequent word in the corpus), 25,000, and 45,000.

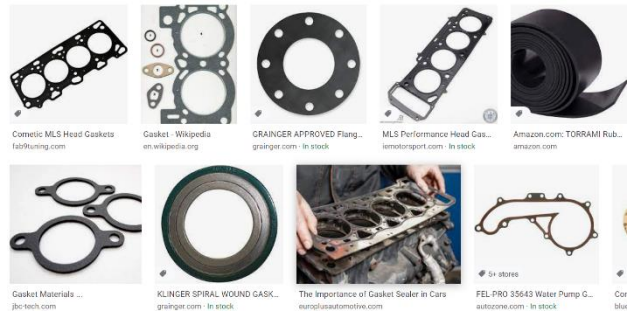

Definitions of gasket

Noun

① a shaped piece or ring of rubber or other material sealing the junction between two surfaces in an engine or other device.
 "oil was leaking from the gasket between the drive flange and the hub"

② **ARCHAIC**
 a cord securing a furled sail to the vard boom or gaff of a sailing vessel

Searching the list

You can also search through the top 60,000 words (lemmas) in ways that are not possible via any other corpus website. You can search by **word form**, such as words with **break** (note: these and the following results just provide a few of the results):

You can limit by **rank order** (#1-60,000), as in the results from the three frequency bands on the first page. You can search by **part of speech**, such as words near #12,000 that are adjectives:

You can search by **pronunciation**, such as words rhyming with *ballet* that have two syllables and that are accented on the second syllable (this is particularly useful for English, where there are sometimes many spellings for a given sound):
